Sony Announces Expanded Capability of Camera Remote Software Development Kit (SDK) for Third Party Developers

New Version 1.01 Empowers Commercial Clients with Addition of Linux Operating System and New Remote Camera Control Functions

Sony today announced an updated version 1.01 for its Camera Remote Software Development Kit, expanding the functionality and versatility of the SDK for developers and integrators.

Sony, the industry leader in both full-frame and mirrorless cameras, has released the SDK based on extensive interest in its camera line-up from commercial customers since this February, and has been further expanding

the solution since its launch.

The new SDK Version 1.01 allows for improved functionality with professional drone applications thanks to the addition of Linux[i] compatibility. Additionally, the new software will increase remote control capabilities over camera settings. New functions, which are appealing to the workflow for a wide variety of professional and commercial industries including security, entertainment and many others, include:

- Ability to set Focus Magnifier Setting
- Utilise expanded Focus Area setting when using AF Area Position[ii]
- Zoom will be adjustable through Zoom Type Status, Zoom Scale, and Zoom Bar Information functions
- Operate detailed White Balance (WB) settings including: Custom WB, Auto WB (AWB) Lock, Biaxial Fine Tuning and Picture Effect.
- Control Media Format, Flash, and interval shooting
- Adjustable frame rate or file format for video shooting
